2008 Sunflower Rally Kit Information Sheet

WHAT IS THE SUNFLOWER RALLY? The Sunflower Rally is a proficiency air rally sponsored by the Kansas Chapter Ninety-Nines International Organization of Women Pilots. The Sunflower Rally Official selects the secret course of approximately 250 miles or less to be flown under Visual Flight Rules (VFR). Before take off, each plane submits an estimate of time and fuel it will take to complete the course. Scoring will be based on correctly identifying 15 to 20 ground points and the accuracy of the time and fuel estimates, each counting for one-third of your total score. For safety reasons, the final timing line will be somewhere other than the airport. There will also be a voluntary spot landing contest with it's own award.

WHERE and WHEN IS THE RALLY HELD? Captain Jack Thomas Airport (EQA) - El Dorado Kansas 316-321-1327, Friday Sept. 5 and Saturday Sept. 6, 2008.

WHO MAY ENTER? The Sunflower Rally is open to any pilot - male or female. A copilot/navigator is required but need not be licensed. All entrants, including the copilot/navigator, must be 16 years of age or older. Age limitations do not apply to passengers.

WHAT KIND OF AIRPLANE? Any fixed wing aircraft with a standard airworthiness certificate, single or twin may compete. No helicopters, homebuilt, or experimental airplanes can participate due to the national 99s insurance requirements.

SCORING. Decisions of the Rally Official will be fair and final. Awarding of trophies at the banquet will be based on the Official's final decisions.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 5 ARRIVAL. Sunflower Rally registration and hospitality will be at EQA between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. Be sure you bring completed DOCUMENTS CHECK LIST & CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE completed by your insurance agent. YOU CANNOT RACE WITHOUT IT!! There will be a mandatory pilot briefing at 7 p.m. on Friday. Contestants will be given the Rally course, the ground-points observation form, and a thorough explanation of the procedures to follow.

SATURDAY, SEPT. 6 ARRIVAL Plan to arrive no later than 8 a.m. Saturday morning and check in at the registration desk. The Saturday morning weather and airport briefing is also mandatory.

PILOT BRIEFINGS. The Friday evening Rally Course briefing and Saturday morning airport and weather briefing are all mandatory. A Pilot cannot compete without attending all briefings. The only exception allowed is for pilots from out of town that cannot come in Friday night due to weather. Please call EQA (316) 321-1327 or Vicki (316) 258-3196 Friday night to let us know your status and we'll arrange for a mini briefing on the Rally Course Saturday morning.

WHEN DO WE FIND OUT WHO WON WHAT IN THE SUNFLOWER RALLY?? Awards will be announced at the Sunflower Rally Barbeque to be held Saturday afternoon. Awards include trophies and other items. Area merchants and 99s have been very generous in donating numerous door prizes.
